- Proven ability to provide high quality building maintenance services including but not limited to plumbing, painting, drywall hanging, taping, mudding and finishing, flooring, molding and trim work, demolition as well as contract oversight management.

- Excellent computer skills including software/hardware set up and troubleshooting in support of new and existing equipment and facilities; airline common use counters; and/or meeting the future needs of the organization.
- A high level of proficiency in Microsoft Office software.
- Ability to perform miscellaneous jobs as required and assists other personnel.

- Demonstrated ability to establish and maintain a positive relationship with customers, vendors, co-workers, management through effective oral and written communication.
