TERMS OF ISSUE

As a holder of a Restricted Area Vehicle Pass Identity Marker I understand the following:

- (a) that the Pass Identity Marker issued to me is the property of The Thunder Bay International Airports Authority.
- (b) that the Pass Identity Marker is not transferable and is only valid for the vehicle described on this application.
- (c) that the Pass Identity Marker is only valid for the areas authorized when there is a required duty to perform.
- (d) that the Pass Identity Marker must be mounted on the vehicle as directed by TBIAAI and be clearly visible at all times when the vehicle is in a Restricted Area.
- (e) that those vehicles issued with TBIAAI Registration Certificates or other identification documentation must carry such certificates or documentation in the vehicles at all times, unless exempted by the issuing authority because of vehicle design.
- (f) that those vehicles requiring registration and payment of fees, must register and pay such fees that are required, and obtain validation stickers. Validation stickers must be affixed to vehicle Pass Identity Markers as directed by TBIAAI and be clearly visible.
- (g) that I must remove the Pass Identity marker from the vehicle and surrender supporting certificates and documentation on demand of the issuing authority.

The following items will be inspected as a part of this application process. Please ensure each item below is acceptable prior to the TBIAAI conducting the mandatory inspection:

Inspection Item	Expectation for passing inspection
Lights	<i>All lights are functional including running lights and marker lights</i>
Horn	<i>Horn is in working order and of an acceptable decibel output</i>
Headlights	<i>high and low in functional order</i>
Brake lights	<i>In working order</i>
Reverse lights and Beeper	<i>In working order</i>
License plate light	<i>(if applicable)</i>
Four Way flashers	<i>All 4 lights are functional when engaged</i>
Beacon	<i>360-degree visibility (if applicable, otherwise see Four Way Flashers)</i>
Front and rear turn signals	<i>In working order</i>
Seat belts	<i>In working order</i>
Windshield Wipers and washers	<i>In working order (If applicable)</i>
Fluid leaks	<i>No signs of any leaks whatsoever.</i>
Tires and tread	<i>Acceptable condition, no signs of degradation or excessive wear</i>
General condition	<i>No signs of risk to safety or operational concerns</i>
Equipment secure	<i>No loose equipment or insecure components</i>
Placement of permit	<i>MUST be affixed to front LEFT bumper.</i>
Fire Extinguisher	<i>min 2.5lb ABC securely fastened to/in vehicle/equipment</i>
